- (iv) The selection in pursuance of the notification will be made on unit basis, subject to the special conditions laid down in G.O. (MS) No 92/80/Home dated, 24.09.1980. A candidate advised for appointment in one unit from the Ranked List prepared is not eligible for transfer to another unit unless he completes five years continuous service from the date of commencement of service in the former unit. Even if transfer is allowed after five years, it will be subject to the rules in G.O(MS)No.4/61/PD dated 02.1.1961. - (a) Other qualifications being equal, the Home guard Volunteers who have completed the term of 3 years in that organisation and who have undergone training during the period of tenure satisfactorily, will be treated as having additional or desirable qualification.
- (b) Proficiency in Sports, Military Training and Membership in National Cadets Corps will be considered as additional qualification.

Candidates will be subjected to a Physical Efficiency Test and must qualify themselves in the following events namely:-

Note:

The physical measurement of candidates will be taken at the time of physical efficiency test and those who do not possess the prescribed physical measurement will not be admitted for the physical efficiency test. If accidents or injuries happen to a candidate while participating in the physical Efficiency Test, he will not be given further chance to participate in the test.
